Most of all, she loved spending time with her family especially her grandchildren. Connie was a loving mother, grandmother, and great grandmother who will be dearly missed by all her family and friends.

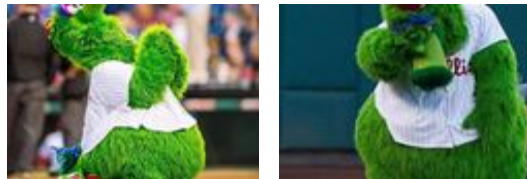
