Cynthia (Cindy) Louise Martin-Furia, age 69, of Media, Pennsylvania, died peacefully at home on January 24, 2026. Cindy will be deeply missed by her loving husband of 42 years, and best friend, Joseph (Joe) Lind Furia.
