Ellen Marie (Auman) Angelitis, age 85, of Downingtown, Pa., passed away on May 15. She was born on April 13, 1941 in Ashland, Pa., to the late Paul E. and Cecelia N. (Kerrigan) Auman. Raised in Philadelphia, she was a 1959 graduate of the historic John W. Hallahan Catholic Girls' High School in Center City, the first diocesan all-girls Catholic high school in the U.S.

Ellen will be fondly remembered for her unwavering love of family and friends, and her sociable nature. She was a devoted wife and mother who preferred a simple no-frills life and enjoyed crafting, reading, watching the Hallmark Channel, and her annual project of making cherished Christmas ornaments for her children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews, and a few select others—a task she lovingly committed her time and artistic talents to for 50 years.

Ellen also had a passion for children and learning. During her boys' primary school years in Philadelphia, she volunteered as a teacher's aide, helping to ensure the classroom ran smoothly, and working one-on-one or in small groups with students who needed extra help—a job she truly loved.

A long-time resident of Arrowhead Lake in the Poconos, Ellen was an active member of the Arrowhead Lake Community Association and organized and participated in many ALCA events and activities. She was a true people

person, always ready to offer a helping hand, an ear to listen, and sage advice.

She is survived by her son Joseph R. and daughter-in-law Lisa Angelitis; son Keith E.
