Emedio "Mimmy" J. Pace, 87 a resident of Broomall, formerly of Westbrook Park, passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on February 27, 2022.

Emedio was born in Philadelphia to the late Philip and Rose (Luzzi) Pace. He proudly served in the United States Army during the Korean War. A former tool and dye maker, Mimmy changed careers and spent the next 12 years as a manager at the Alpine Inn in Springfield, PA. Following his time in the restaurant business, Mimmy became the owner of the P&M Deli in Clifton Heights until his retirement.

While raising his children, Mimmy coached Little League sports for the Westbrook Park Boys Club, was a Fourth Degree Knight in the Knights of Columbus and, through his relationships developed at the Alpine Inn, was very active in several civic organizations. He enjoyed watching the Phillies and Eagles, vacationing in Florida, and an occasional evening out with family and friends. Most of all Mimmy loved spending time with his family. He was a devoted and loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather who will be missed dearly by all who knew him.
