



Francis "Chickie" Joseph Dee Jr.

Francis Joseph (Chickie) Dee, Jr., 87, of Livingston, Texas, passed away peacefully on January 20, 2026.

Born on June 10, 1938, in Darby, Pennsylvania, Chickie was the son of Francis and Isabel (nee Smith) Dee. He was a graduate of Monsignor Bonner High School in Drexel Hill, Pennsylvania, and served in the United States Army during the late 1950s and as a reservist until the mid-1960's. He ended his military service as an Ordnance Supply Specialist after achieving awards as an M-1 Rifle Marksman and M-14 Rifle Expert.

Chickie was a devout Catholic and a member of the Secular Franciscan Order (SFO), as well as a member of the Knights of Columbus. After a business career involving various administrative positions, he was also a shuttle bus driver for several years providing transportation assistance for seniors and patients living within Delaware County. Later in life he was an active member of the Escapees RV Club in Livingston, Texas, which was a community and lifestyle that he thoroughly enjoyed.

Chickie was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Margaret "Nancy" (Dee) Delloso, and his brother-in-law John Delloso. He is survived by his niece Mary A. (Kristofer) Spahr, and his nephews John M. (Arlene) Delloso, Francis D. (Theresa) Delloso, and Vincent A. Delloso.

Funeral services were held on January 23, 2026, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Livingston, Texas, with a visitation at Pace Funeral Home. A family viewing was also held on February 4, 2026, at Williams Lombardo Funeral Home in Clifton Heights, Pennsylvania, followed by a private interment at Saints Peter and Paul Cemetery in Springfield, Pennsylvania.
