Geoffrey Waddington, 76, died on January 1, 2021, at his home in Coatesville, PA, after a lengthy illness. Born in England, Mr. Waddington was a graduate of Bradford School for Boys and later attended Bradford University. He became a United States citizen in 2018.

Formerly a resident of Springfield, Delaware County, Mr. Waddington moved to Coatesville 6 years ago. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of the Vietnam War. Upon his retirement he taught manufacturing at the Delaware County Community College. He was a member of the Covenant United Methodist Church in Springfield where he served as an usher and a member of the music committee. He was an avid soccer player and coached youth sports for the Springfield Athletic Association.

He is survived by his wife, M. Paige Schroeder Waddington, three sons, Trevor (Meredith) Waddington of Olney, MD, Douglas (Anne) Waddington of Scottsdale, AZ, and Brett Waddington of West Chester, PA, a daughter, Julie (Jason) Stolnis of West Chester, PA; a sister, Lynne (John) Ellis of England; as well as his grandchildren, Colin, Brooke, Andrew, Kerris, Benjamin, Ellis, Harper and Caden.
