It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of George Gerald Ott, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, who passed away peacefully on December 27, 2024, at the age of 86, surrounded by his loving family.

George is survived by his devoted wife of 62 years, Dolores (née Bachanskas) Ott; his four daughters, Lisa (Chris), Colleen, Jennifer (Tony), and Allison (Glenn); his six grandchildren, Jack, Connor, Tyler, Jillian, Sophia, and Garrett; and his sister-in-law Mary (née Bachanskas) Marinelli. George was preceded in death by his parents, Sara and Fillmore Ott; two brothers, Joseph and Fillmore; and is survived by his brother, William.

A graduate of West Catholic High School, George went on to serve his country as a proud member of the United States Marine Corps. He had a long and distinguished career with the railroad, beginning with the Pennsylvania Railroad and retiring from Conrail in 2000.

George's passion for sports extended beyond his professional life. He played semi-pro football and was a dedicated football coach for the Clifton Heights Boys Club (CHBC), where he was a founding member. He also spent countless hours supporting his daughters at their sporting events and was actively involved with the Clifton Heights Swim Club for many years.

Before retiring to Naples, George and Dolores lived in Drexel Hill, PA, for 27 years and then in Secane, PA, for 31 years. They also enjoyed the serenity of

their vacation home in the Poconos for 34 years.

In Naples, George stayed active, playing bocce, golf, participating in water aerobics, and serving as president of his Homeowners Association and as a member of the community master board. Despite living in Florida, he remained a loyal Philadelphia sports fan, especially supporting the Eagles and Phillies.

He will be remembered as a kind, generous man who was deeply loved by his family and by all who knew him.
