Harry J. Coyle Jr., age 78, a resident of Clifton Heights, passed away on May 7, 2025.

Harry was born in Philadelphia and raised in Springfield to the late Harry and Helen (Kurtz) Coyle. He was a graduate of Springfield High School and attended Penn State University. Harry honorably served his country in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War and was wounded in battle receiving two Purple Hearts. Following his military service, he became the Pennsylvania Commander for the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) and traveled across the country to speak on their behalf. Harry also worked for the Delaware Prison System as the Director of the Drug and Alcohol Program. He cherished time spent at Ocean City, NJ, the Delaware beaches, and the Outer Banks. Harry was a devoted Kansas City Chiefs fan. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather who will be dearly missed by all his family and friends.

Predeceased by his sisters, Theresa and Kathleen.

He is survived by his wife, Christine (Kvietkas) Coyle; children, Jonathan Coyle, Kevin (Brittney) Coyle, and Lyndsay (Jessica) Coyle; grandchildren, Joseph and Kylie. Also survived by his nieces and nephews.
