Mr. James D. Parmiter, 84, died on February 3, 2019, at the Crozer Chester Medical Center in Upland, PA.

Born in McKeesport, PA, Mr. Parmiter was a graduate of Penn State University where he was a SAE brother. He was a resident of Springfield since 1958. He was employed by Boeing Aircraft in Ridley Park, retiring as a director of safety after 20 years. He later worked at the Philadelphia Navy Yard, retiring in 1996. A member of the Navy Reserves, he retired with the rank of Commander.

Mr. Parmiter was a long time member of the Covenant United Methodist Church in Springfield. He was a 50 year member of the Masonic Blue Lodge and also belonged to the Knights Templar, Shrine and Royal Arch Masonic orders. He served as a member of the Springfield School Board, as well as with the Delaware County Intermediate Unit. He was a member of the Springfield Lion's Club as well as the American Philatelic Society. He was an avid stamp collector.

He is survived by his wife, Nancy nee (Light) Parmiter, two sons, James (Jan) Parmiter and David Parmiter, a brother, Jon Parmiter and a sister, Suzanne Sturni. He is also survived by 4 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren.
