James T. Pitcherello, III "Pitch" age 58, a resident of Havertown formerly of Clifton Heights passed away on March 1, 2025.

Jim was born in Darby to the late James T. and Elsie (Zivello) Pitcherello. He was a 1985 graduate of Upper Darby High School, The Pennsylvania Institute of Technology and Widener University. For the past 24 years Jim worked for Saint Gobain in Malvern, working his way to an Executive position at the company. Growing up in Clifton, Jim excelled in everything he did. His true love was football and he was one of the best. In high school, Jim was first team All Delco and first team All-State. When he graduated from high school, he held the state record for most tackles in a single season and most tackles in a career. In 2021, Jim was inducted into the Upper Darby High School Sports Hall of Fame. Jim was a member of the Italian American Citizens Association in Clifton Heights. He was an avid Philadelphia Sports fan. He loved fishing, boating and golfing. Jim was a kind and caring soul who was fiercely loyal to his friends and family. He was a loving brother, nephew, uncle and great uncle who will be dearly missed by all his family and friends.

Jim is survived by his two sisters, Karen (Brett Voisin) Pitcherello and Laurie (Tom) Pitcherello-Mascio; niece, Shannon (Gary) Christy; nephew, Patrick (Kara) Dolan Jr.; great nephews, Dante Christy, Patrick Dolan III and Gary Christy III; uncle , Sam Zivello.
