

## John P. Dancy

November 4, 1962 - July 5, 2022

JOHN “OLDSCHOOL” DANCY SR of Primos, PA, prominently known as a Car Collector and Lincoln and Continental Mark VII Historian, peacefully passed away on July 5, 2022. Born on November 4, 1962, in Philadelphia, PA to Ernest Dancy and Helen Turner, he was one of nine children. John attended James Alcorn Elementary School, Anna Howard Shaw Junior High School, West Philadelphia High School, Coastal Carolina Community College, and The Computer Learning Center of Philadelphia. John was a former United States Marine and honorably served his country from 1980 to 1983. In 1985, John married Sharon Watkins and Fathered a son, John Dancy Jr. John and Sharon divorced five years later. In 1991, John married Fontaine “Twig” Corley, who passed away in 1997. In 2002, John married Lynette Hendershot and Fathered two children, Adam and Sara Dancy. John and Lynette divorced in 2016. In 2017 John married Valerie Pearsall. Formally educated as a Computer Programmer, John created the first search engine on the internet for finding a doctor. The Philadelphia Medical Mall (TPMM.COM) was a thriving business from 1997 to 2003. Self-educated in Thermodynamics, John worked as a Plant Operator at The Hospital Of The University Of Pennsylvania from 1994 to present. John often said, “I genuinely love what I do professionally and have the best career on the planet; they actually pay me to make people comfortable. I’ll never retire!” John maintained a unique collection of Lincoln and Continental Mark VII automobiles curated by Joseph Mazzone and Christopher Thomas Pinder.

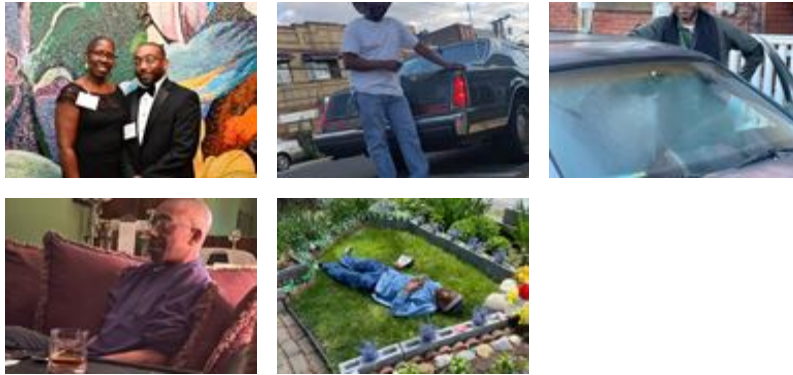
