John was born in Philadelphia to Fidel and Marie (nee Metzger) Fay on December 10, 1925. He grew up in Kensington with his grandparents, John and Anna Metzger from 1930 to 1950. He cherished growing up with his great-grandmother Katharina and his grandmother Anna. During those years he shared that home with many cousins, including Joe and Maryann Keyes, Ruth, Mary and Doris Metzger along with his aunts and uncles.

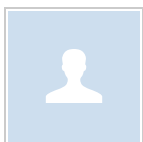
