Laurie Braconnier-Schol passed away on June 3, 2021 in hospice at Reading Hospital at the age of 58. Laurie was born to John & Joan Braconnier May 7, 1963 at Fitzgerald Mercy Hospital in Lansdowne, PA. She was raised in Springfield Delaware County.

Laurie had many accomplishments in her lifetime. She was a graduate in the Class of 1981 at Cardinal O'Hara High School. 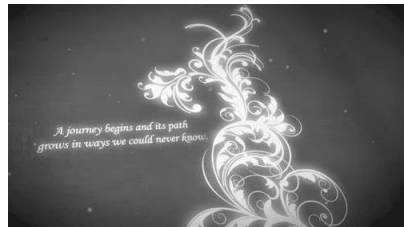
Funeral Services and Interment will be held privately

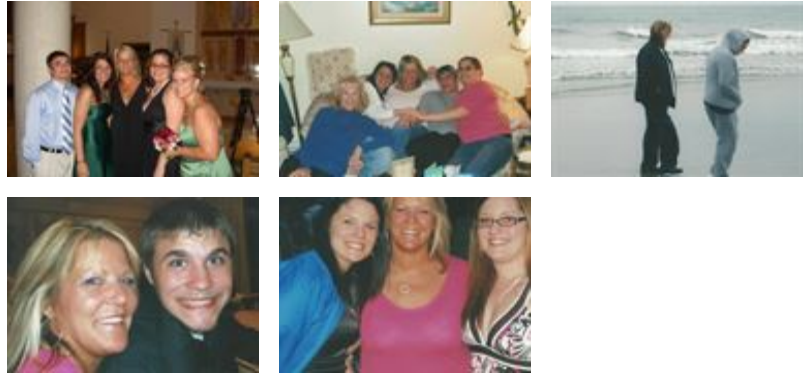
