Robert S. Giffear, 88, formerly of Secane and South Philadelphia passed away on January 1, 2026.

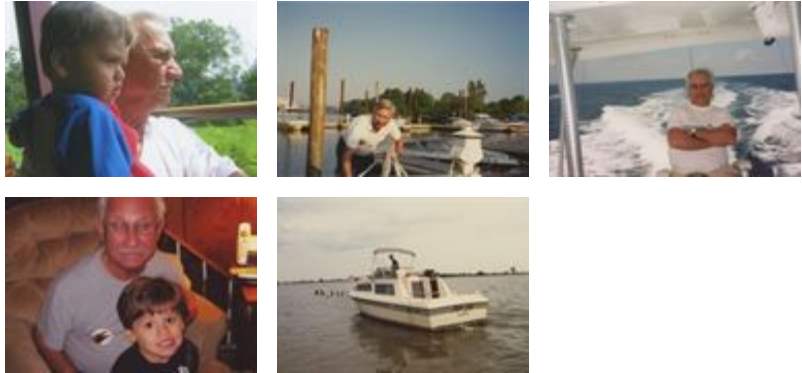
