She moved to Hawaii to help raise her first 2 grandchildren before returning to Pennsylvania to help raise the next 3.

Sherry's most powerful attributes were her empathy, caring, and selflessness. She always put others before herself. If a coworker liked a shirt she had, she would go home, wash it, and give it as a gift the next day. When her sons wanted to go somewhere with their friends, she would pile everyone into her minivan and take them anywhere.

As Sherry joins her parents, she is survived by many loved ones. First off is her younger sister Becky. She had 4 children: Sam (Kenneth Robinson), James "Jimmy", Kevin (Jennifer nee McCullough), and Joseph (Laura nee Scordato). She also had the distinct privilege and joy to be the Grammy of 5 incredible grandchildren: Euna, Elijah, Kevin Jr., Danielle, and Jessica.
