Thomas W. Babcock, age 91, a longtime resident of Springfield, passed away peacefully on September 10, 2025.

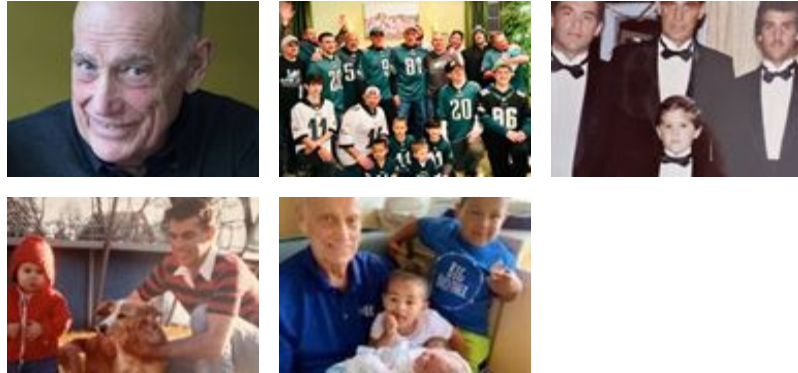
